



Valentine's Card with Surprise Effect

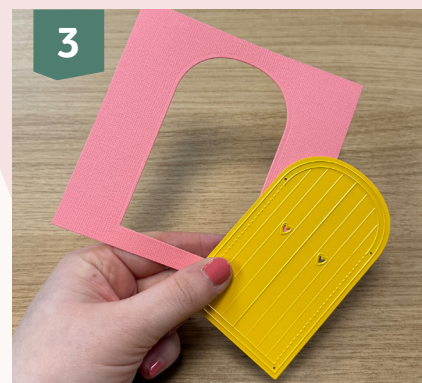
Create this romantic Valentine's card with a surprising opening flap and delight someone with a personal and loving message. This creative project is perfect for Valentine's Day crafting and shows how you can use paper, layers and small details to make a card that truly stands out. Thanks to the playful surprise effect and space for a handwritten note, you give your Valentine something unique and meaningful. Ideal for anyone who loves getting creative around Valentine's Day.



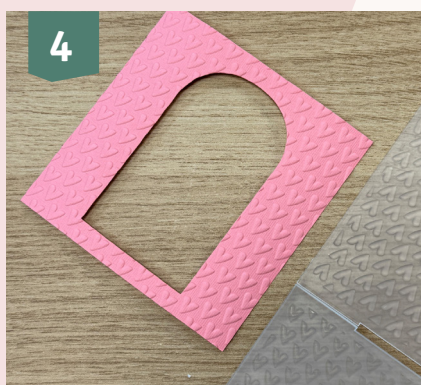
1 Cut a top-fold card measuring 13 × 13 cm. Then cut the following pieces of paper: dark red 12.5 × 12.5 cm, light pink 12 × 12 cm, and kraft paper 10 × 10 cm.



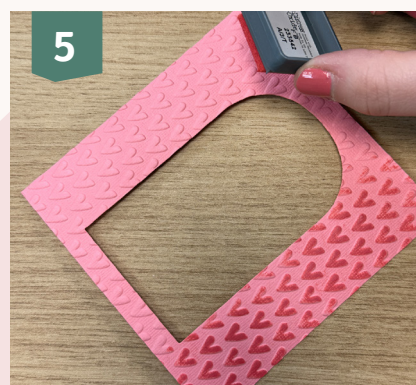
2 Adhere the dark red paper and the kraft paper to the top-fold card.



3 Die-cut a door from the light pink paper and die-cut the same door again from white paper.



4 Emboss the light pink paper using a die-cutting machine.



5 Lightly swipe an ink pad over the paper. The texture creates a beautiful effect and adds depth.



6 Adhere the treated pink paper onto the kraft paper.





7
Apply glue along the edges of the door, making sure the doors can still be opened.



8
Place and glue the door into the opening.



9
Attach punched hearts in various colours to hemp twine. For this project, use eight hearts.



10
While the glue is drying, write or stamp a message on the kraft paper



11
Secure the hemp twine to the inside of the doors.



12
Finish the project by adhering two punched doves to the kraft paper.
