




Make a Christmas card with magical powder


Discover the magic of Christmas crafts with this festive DIY! Learn how to make your own Christmas cards using Nuvo Shimmer Powder — for a sparkling, personal touch that makes every holiday greeting shine.

1



Place a sheet of watercolour paper on your work mat and secure it with magnets. Fill a spray bottle with water and generously mist the paper.

2



Gently sprinkle some Nuvo Shimmer Powder onto the wet paper and let the powder work its magic. Allow it to dry completely.

3



Once the paper is dry, punch out several Christmas baubles.

4



Use a hand punch to make a small hole at the top of each bauble.

5



Thread pieces of hemp cord through the holes in the baubles.

6



Attach the cords to the back of the baubles and secure them with a small piece of 3D foam tape.



7



Take a sheet of blue cardstock measuring 4.3 x 8.6 inch (11 x 22 cm) and create torn edges using a tearing ruler.

8



Stick the baubles onto the blue paper, fold the cords over, and secure them at the back.

Finally, mount the blue paper with the baubles onto a card of 4.3 x 8.6 inch (11 x 22 cm). Add a cheerful Christmas message, and your card is ready!
