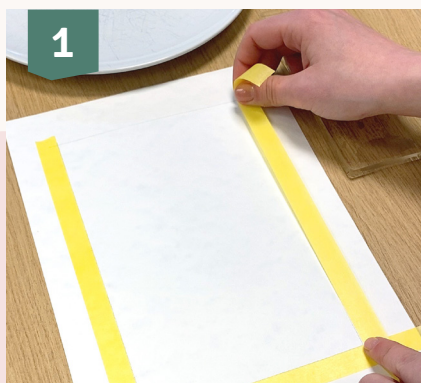


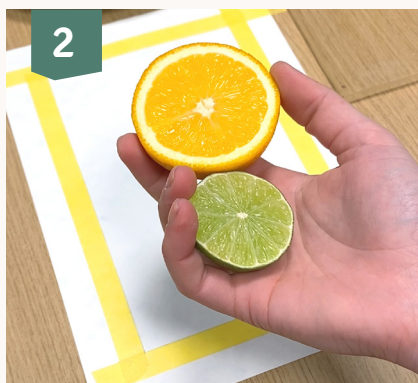


Stamping a Citrus Print with Acrylic Paint

Create this summer print with real citrus fruits and acrylic paint! Unleash your creativity and experiment with different fruits and colours.



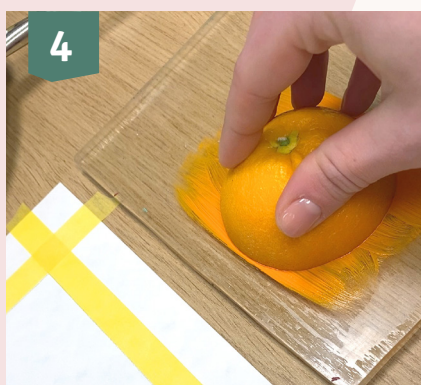
1 Take a sheet of off-white watercolour paper and use masking tape to create a frame for your design.



2 Cut an orange and a lime in half (or use another citrus fruit). Let the halves dry for about an hour before continuing.



3 Apply a layer of paint to a gel printing plate – this will serve as your ink pad.



4 Press one half of the orange into the paint and stamp it onto the paper.



5 Fill the entire space with prints of the orange and lime, alternating colours for a playful and vibrant effect.



6 Once the print is dry, use a black fineliner to add extra details or contrast.





Carefully remove the tape. If it sticks too much and causes tearing, use a hairdryer or heat tool to loosen it.
