

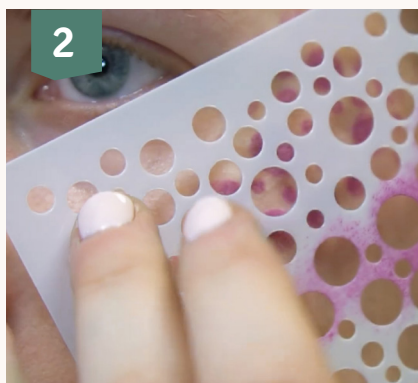


Face painting with stencils

Fancy a colourful face-painting moment? With templates and stencils, you can quickly create a neat and playful result, even if you're not a face-painting expert. Follow this DIY and discover how crafting with stencils fits perfectly with face painting.



1
Make sure the face is clean and dry. Choose your face paint colours, a stencil and daubers/dabbers.



2
Place the stencil carefully on the face, for example on the cheek or next to the eye. Hold it firmly so it doesn't move.



3
Lightly dip a dauber into the face paint and dab (don't wipe!) over the stencil. Work in thin layers for the best result.



4
Add a second colour if you like for extra depth or a playful effect. Keep the stencil in place while you continue dabbing.



5
Remove the stencil and stick small rhinestones in the centre of the flowers. This makes your design look even more lively.



6
Let the face paint dry briefly, check that everything is secure and admire the result. Ready for a radiant look!
