



Craft binoculars with a craft kit

Looking for a fun and creative craft project to do with kids? Make glitter binoculars together using paper, tape, and cheerful decorations. Simple, colourful, and full of imagination!



1 Take two pink A5 sheets from the Vaessen Creative Fun Kit 2. Cut them into squares of 5.8 x 5.8 inches (14.8 x 14.8) cm.



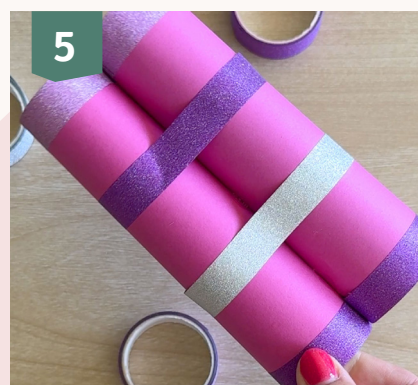
2 Roll each sheet into a tube and glue the ends together. Press firmly.



3 Wrap glitter tape around both ends of the tubes and press down well.



4 Glue the two tubes together, preferably with the seams facing each other so they're hidden.



5 Wrap two more strips of glitter tape around the middle, across both tubes.



6 Decide which side will be the top, then make a small hole on each side, about 1,2 inches (3 cm) from the edge, using a hole punch or scissors.

Thread a piece of cord through the holes and tie a knot.

Time to decorate! Use rhinestones, foam stickers, googly eyes – whatever you like.

You can make all kinds of fun variations. Let your creativity run wild!
