



## Christmas Card: Tree with Heart Punches

Bring the Christmas spirit into your home with this festive Christmas craft project! Use a heart punch to easily make a handmade Christmas card shaped like a tree. Perfect for adding a special personal touch to your holiday greetings.



1 Choose the colours you want to use from the paper pad. In this example, three different shades of green have been selected.



2 Place the light green paper in the holly embossing folder and run it through the embossing machine. Then trim it to 5.5 x 5.5 inches (14 x 14 cm) so it fits nicely on the card.



3 Take two darker shades of green and punch hearts with the smallest and medium heart punch from the set.



4 Punch enough hearts to build a complete Christmas tree and stick them onto the embossed paper using small pieces of foam tape.



5 Take a strip of white paper and stamp a fun Christmas message on it. Cut it to 1.6 x 0.8 inches (4 x 2 cm). Also cut a green strip of inches 1.8 x 1 inches (4.5 x 2.5 cm) and glue them together.



6 Take a folded base card of 6.1 x 6.1 inches (15.5 x 15.5 cm). Cut a sheet of dark green paper to 5.7 x 5.7 inches (14.5 x 14.5 cm) and stick it as a background on the card.





Then glue the embossed paper with the heart-shaped tree onto the card.



Finally, use foam tape to attach the Christmas message in one corner of the card.
