



## Make a paper Easter basket

Looking for a fun crafting idea for Easter? With this simple DIY, you can create a cute Easter basket that's perfect for holding chocolate eggs or small gifts. This creative Easter project is quick to make and fun to make together with kids. It's a great way to give your Easter decorations a personal and cheerful touch.



**1**  
Cut a piece of paper measuring 1.1 x 4.7 inches (3 x 12 cm). You can adjust the size if you are using larger or smaller eggs.



**2**  
Decorate the paper with markers in fun Easter or spring patterns.



**3**  
Glue the short sides of the paper together to form a small tube.



**4**  
Punch a circle out of paper. For this DIY, we use a scalloped circle for a more playful effect.



**5**  
Apply glue with a glue gun to the circle and firmly attach the tube on top.



**6**  
Cut a strip of paper measuring 0.4 x 4.7 inches (1 x 12 cm) for the handle. You can also adjust this size depending on the size of the basket.





7  
Use a hole punch to make two holes opposite each other in the tube.



8  
Then make a hole at both ends of the paper strip.



9  
Attach the handle by fastening the strip to the tube with split pins, and your Easter basket is ready!
