



## Make a card with postage stamps

Looking to make a colourful and original card? In this DIY project, you'll create a cheerful greeting card with post-stamp-inspired motifs as the creative highlight.



1  
Cut a piece of white cardstock to make a folded card measuring 3.9 x 5.8 inches (10 x 14.8 cm) (open: 7.9 x 5.8 inches (20 x 14.8 cm)). Cut a separate piece of white cardstock measuring 3.7 x 5.6 inches (9.5 x 14.3 cm).

Place the postage stamp stencil on the loose piece of cardstock. Using a dauber, apply ink to the top row of stamp motifs. Use the colour Saltwater Taffy.



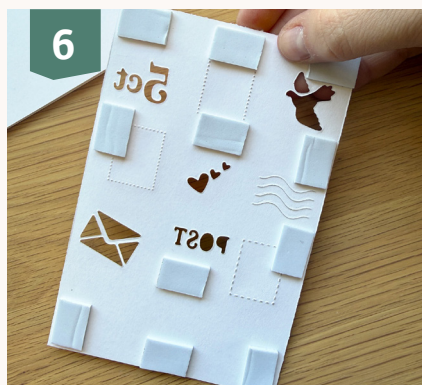

Place the postage stamp stencil on the loose piece of cardstock. Using a dauber, apply ink to the top row of stamp motifs. Use the colour Saltwater Taffy.

Colour the bottom row with Fossilized Amber ink, blending in the same way.



5  
Let the ink dry completely. Then place a die on each stamp motif and run the sheet through a die-cutting and embossing machine.



6  
Attach the decorated sheet to the folded card using foam tape.
