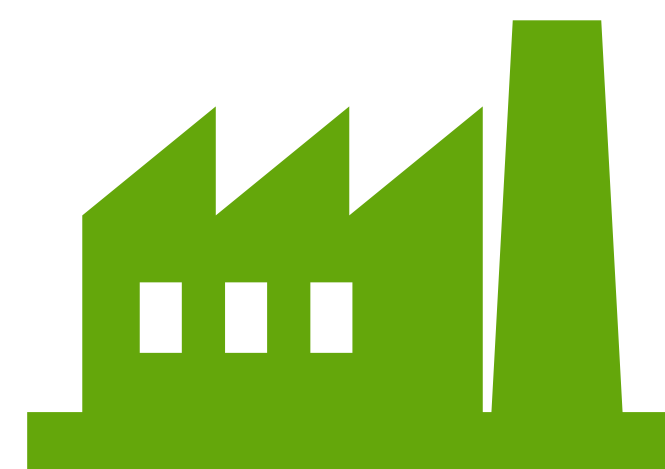


JCF Industry Lecture
